Wildlife Group update: the Wild Watch Pilot, launched on 20th July, created lots of interest, despite the rain: Using the iNaturalist app, by early August there were over 400 observations in the park, identifying 164 different species of plants, insects and animals. The group hopes to run a different Wild Watch each season, looking at fungi, butterflies, birds, etc, as appropriate.
